Liability: I, the undersigned Buyer, hereby consent to hold the Center free of any and all liability, claims, or actions whatsoever, arising from any injuries, accidents, illness, etc., due to attendance at Camp.

Media: I, the Buyer irrevocably authorize the Center, its successors and assigns, and those acting under its authority, to copyright, use, publish for art, advertising, trade, or any other lawful purpose whatsoever, photographic portraits, pictures, or videotapes and artwork of Student in which Student may be included in whole or in part.

Emergency Release: I, the Buyer, hereby allow the Center to take such actions as is deemed necessary by the Center to provide emergency and medical assistance for the Student.

Cancellation Policy: I, the Buyer, understand and agree that any payment received will not be returned to the student or buyer for any reason, but in some circumstances, may be credited to future classes as space is available, on a case by case basis. I, the Buyer, further understand and agree that one week prior written notice and a \$20 cancellation fee is required to cancel any registered camp and that to register for another camp, the original camp must first be cancelled.
